

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING OF THE KIMBERLY VILLAGE BOARD

MARCH 14, 2016

President Kuen called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Members present: President Kuen and Trustees Hruzek, Hietpas, Opsteen, Weber, Hammen, and Trentlage. Absent: none. Also present: Administrator Hammatt, Street Commissioner Vander Velden, Community Enrichment Director Schaefer, and Engineer Werner.

Discussion was had on upcoming street projects, alley paving, financing, etc. Kimberly Avenue bids are in, with the low bid about \$2,173,000. Hammatt to report back on other particulars. – Vander Velden looking to handle a \$40,000 alley repaving project this year and the consensus of the Board is okay with it. – A question from a resident was brought to President Kuen's attention about doing away with special assessments. The Board was asked if there was any interest to doing away with special assessment and only one Board member was in favor. – There is a patch on 3rd Street causing issues and Vander Velden will be having WE Energies come back to address it. – Cobblestone Lane will be closed for a few hours on March 15th to run utilities to the Senior Care Facility.
