

## SNOW REMOVAL NOTICE

TO PROPERTY OWNERS IN THE VILLAGE OF KIMBERLY

– NO FURTHER NOTICE GIVEN –

Notice is hereby given to each person who owns, occupies, or controls land that fronts upon or abuts any sidewalk in the Village of Kimberly, Outagamie County, State of Wisconsin. The Village of Kimberly Code of Ordinances Ch. 430 -10, states that sidewalks are to be kept clear of all snow and ice, to a minimum of five (5) feet in width, within twenty-four (24) hours from the time the snow ceases to accumulate on said sidewalk. In the event that ice has formed on any sidewalk in such a manner that it cannot be removed, the sidewalk shall be sprinkled with material to accelerate melting or prevent slipping. Furthermore, no person shall in any way deposit any snow or ice onto any public street, alley, sidewalk, or public land dedicated to public use. No further written or verbal notice will be given to violators. Failure to comply will result in sidewalks being cleared by the Village and billed at a rate of \$75.00 per hour, plus equipment usage. A minimum of one hour will be charged to clear sidewalks.
