

Minutes  
Kimberly Planning Commission  
January 4, 2010

Chairman Chuck Kuen called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Commissioners present were Paul Hermes, Dean Schiesl, Norb Karner, Duane Biese, Dave Opsteen and Steve Schrieber. Also present were Rick Hermus Village Administrator, Eric Fowle representing the East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission, and five Village residents.

After a motion by Mr. Karner and a second from Mr. Opsteen, the Planning Commission unanimously voted to convene to a public hearing to field comments regarding the final draft for the 2030 Comprehensive Plan. Eric Fowle did a short presentation of the Plan; keying in on the important points and fielding a few questions from the Commissioners and the public guests that were present.

When he finished Chairman Kuen and Commissioner Opsteen went through a list of items that they felt needed corrections or changes. All of these items were tabbed by Mr. Fowle, they included typographical errors, the rewording of definitions and paragraphs, map errors and other minor changes to make the document more precise and correct as it described where the Village is and where it is headed in the next twenty years.

With a motion by Commissioner Hermes to close the public hearing, and a second by Commissioner Schrieber, the Commission voted to close the hearing.

After a few final comments from the residents and businessman present, Commissioner Opsteen made a motion to approve the 2030 Comprehensive Plan contingent on the changes discussed being corrected. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Biese, the vote of the Commission was unanimous.

At 5:58 p.m. Commissioner Karner made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Hermes seconded his motion; the Commissioners then voted unanimously to adjourn.
