

**MEETING OF THE KIMBERLY SEX OFFENDER RESIDENCY BOARD
DECEMBER 19, 2018**

Chairman Block called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Members present for roll call were Nancy Bourassa, Kraig Hughs and Kyle Fuller. Marica Trentlage and Vicki Tessen were absent and excused. Also present: FVMPD Officer Lambie, Officer Uebelher, Mr. Heller and one resident.

Hughs/Bourassa to approve the minutes of the June 25, 2018 SORB meeting as presented. Carried. Unanimous.

Held a Review Hearing on Appeal #2018-02 filed by William Heller to reside at 401 ½ Marcella St., Kimberly. Mr. Heller appeared. Officer Uebelher gave an update on Mr. Heller's past six months and the conditions placed on his residency. FVMPD has checked in unannounced over the past six months to monitor Mr. Heller's compliance with the conditions. Mr. Heller's job status was discussed, he is recently employed. Mr. Heller's enrollment in college ended mid-fall. FVMPD reported that there have been no reported incidents involving Mr. Heller. Mr. Heller has complied with check-ins and remains alcohol free. FVMPD's main concern was the lack of consistent employment. No other concerns were expressed.

Mr. Heller spoke to his employment history and college enrollment. He works with temp agencies and has recently secured employment. Mr. Heller expressed his desire to have the condition of FVMPD check-ins removed.

One village resident expressed concerns with lack of employment as it relates to recidivism. He also expressed concerns over Mr. Heller's request to terminate FVMPD's check-ins. The resident requested revocation of residency or at a minimum, continuation of conditions placed on residency.

Hughs/Fuller to convene into closed session pursuant to stated agenda. Carried. Unanimous.

Bourassa/Fuller to convene into open session. Carried. Unanimous.

Chairman Block informed Mr. Heller that his review hearing has resulted in continuation of the probationary period for six (6) months. During this period, he may not consume alcohol and FVMPD may check on him as frequently as their schedule allows. The Board will request an update from FVMPD in June of 2019, and based on that, the Board will either remove the conditions, continue the conditions, or reverse their decision to accept his residency in the Village of Kimberly. An official letter will be sent following these proceedings.

The Board received an update from FVMPD on prior appeals. There is no record of incidents or concerns from prior appeals. FVMPD will continue to monitor.

Fuller/Hughs to adjourn. Carried. Unanimous.
