A tornado is a rapidly rotating column of air that can cause great destruction. Other names for a tornado are twister, cyclone, whirlwind or waterspout. Few people realize that a cyclone twists counterclockwise in the Northern Hemisphere and clockwise below the equator.

Once the debris is removed, this area will soon be resurrected as a new park. Make sure you come to see the fall colors.

Do not go to the listed coords as you are not looking for a waterspout. The cache is located at N44 1A.TWI and W088 2S.TER. Use the following clues to come up with the numbers. Be warned that the gps signal spins like crazy in this area, but it will eventually give you a firm footing for finding the cache.
