FENCE PERMITS

- -When applying for a fence permit the owner or contractor must submit a plat plan of his/her lot showing where the fence will be located. -Included on this plan should be the home, garage and any other structures (sheds, pools, etc.) that are pertinent to the lot.
- -The style (barricade, privacy, vinyl, chainlink) and height (not to exceed 6 feet) of the fence must be included on the plan.
- Any fence located on a corner lot or in the front (yard) setback area must meet the Village Code and be approved by the Building Inspector. There are limitations to fences that are in the front yard.
- -Before purchasing or signing a contract with a fence contractor make sure you know if the fence you like and the location you want to place it will be approved per Village Code.
- -Fences can be placed on your lot line. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER TO KNOW WHERE THE LOT LINES ARE LOCATED**. The most accurate means of locating lot lines is by hiring a certified surveyor. The Village can assist at locating lot lines but these locates will not be official.
