

Kimberly Single-Stream Recycling Cart Guide

- Place **all** recyclable material into your cart. There is no need to separate paper from glass, aluminum, plastic and tin.
- Please **do not** place recyclables in **plastic bags**.
- **Do not** place trash in your recycling cart.
- All recyclables must fit into your cart with the lid closed. For overflow recyclables, you may:
 - Save for a future collection event.
 - Ask a neighbor if they have extra room in their cart.
 - Bring to County drop off site, located at 1419 Holland Rd, Appleton Monday-Friday 7am-3:30pm and Saturdays 7am-11am.
- A **few** large cardboard boxes may be flattened and cut to no larger than 3 ft X 3 ft and placed under the lid of the cart.
- Place your recycling cart with the front of the lid facing the street and the wheels of the cart toward your house. Please keep your recycling cart 4 ft away from obstructions such as, mailboxes, utility poles, trees and parked cars.
- Keep your recycling cart 4 ft away from your trash cart. The best solution is to put your carts on opposite sides of your driveway.
- Make sure you place you cart at the curb either by 6:00 a.m. the day of pickup or the night before, and remove your cart 24 hours after collection.
- Carts cannot be placed on top of snow banks, they must be ground level.
