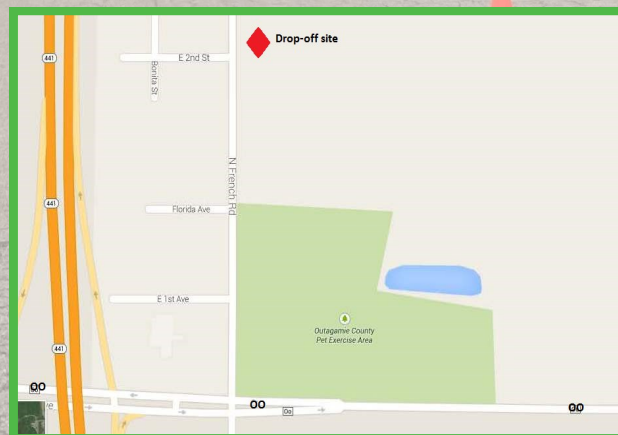
DIRECTIONS

2. No containers over 5 gallons.
3. No trailer or full truck bed sized loads.
4. Materials must be in trunk, lift gate, or truck bed. No materials will be collected from front or back seats.
5. Drivers must remain in vehicles.

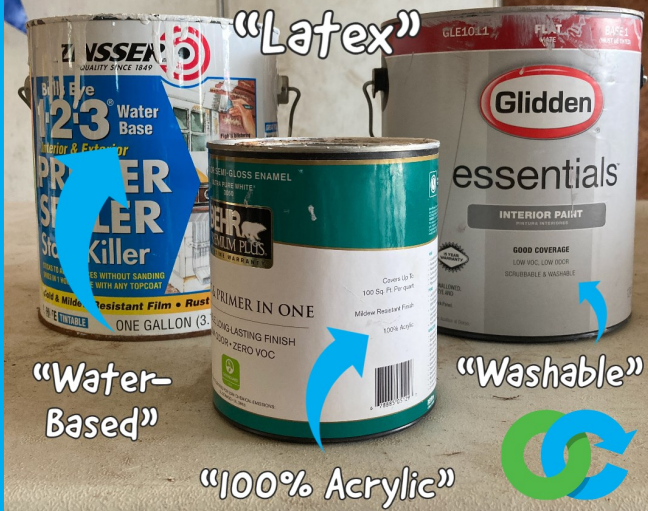

This collection program allows Outagamie County residents, including all citizens of Appleton and New London, to dispose of their hazardous materials safely and properly, free of charge!

NON-HAZARDOUS



Latex Paint is NOT HAZARDOUS!

Let it dry out. Dispose of dried paint and paint cans in the trash.

LATEX PAINT

SMALL AMOUNTS:

1. REMOVE THE LID
2. OCCASIONALLY STIR THE PAINT UNTIL DRY
3. DISPOSE OF DRIED PAINT AND PAINT CANS IN THE TRASH

LARGE AMOUNTS:

1. LINE A BOX WITH A PLASTIC BAG
2. PLACE AN ABSORBENT MATERIAL (KITTY LITTER, OIL-DRY) ON THE BOTTOM
3. POUR LAYER OF PAINT - REPEAT IF NECESSARY
4. DISPOSE OF DRIED PAINT AND PAINT CANS IN TRASH

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

Including but not limited to...

- Flammable Liquids:**
- Gasoline • **NO ON-SITE "POUR OFFS"**
 - Kerosene Motor Oil * Vehicle Batteries *
 - 1 Pound Propane Tanks Car Chemicals
- Aerosol Cans:** Spray Paints
- Paint Products:**
- Oil-based Paints Lead-based Paints
 - Paint Thinners/Strippers Varnish/Stain
- Pesticides/Herbicides/Insecticides:**
- Weed Killers Poisons
- Acids & Bases:**
- Muriatic Acid Lime Out
 - Rust Remover Ammonia
 - Floor Cleaner Drano
 - Pool Chemicals Toxic Household Cleaners
- Mercury Fire Extinguishers**

1 POUND (16 OZ) PROPANE TANKS

EMPTY:

1. BRING TO 'RESOURCE RECOVERY PARK'
2. DISPOSE IN 'PROPANE TANK' GAYLORD BOX FOR FREE

NOT EMPTY:

- A. DRAIN COMPLETELY AND THEN DISPOSE AT 'RESOURCE RECOVERY PARK' FOR FREE
- OR
- B. BRING TO A HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS MATERIALS COLLECTION EVENT

IF THERE IS PROPANE IN THE TANK, BRING TO A HAZARDOUS MATERIALS COLLECTION EVENT!

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

- Smoke Detectors
- Return to Manufacturer
- Explosives
- Ammunition, Black Powder, Fireworks, Flares
- Biological Waste & Sharps
- Medications & Pharmaceuticals
- Infectious Waste
- Radioactive Materials
- Appliances & Electronics
- Batteries & Light Bulbs
- Trash
