Seasonal Lifeguard – Sunset Beach Swim Facility

SALARY RANGE: \$11.78 - \$13.39 Depending on Qualifications

ADDITIONAL BENEFITS: Annual swimsuit stipend, beach swag, and certification reimbursement

MINIMUM AGE RESTRICTION: 15 years old minimum to be eligible for lifeguard certification

REPORT TO WORK LOCATION: Sunset Beach Swimming Facility, 1010 Fulcer Ave.

TYPICAL HOURS: 12:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m., any fair-weather day throughout the summer

SEASON DETAILS: Sunset Beach is open beginning June 2nd and closes for the people swimming season August 13th followed by Bark at the Beach dog swimming season August 14th – September 1st. Required staff training date will be held Sunday, May 21st starting at 9 a.m. with opportunity for staff to begin with season start up at the beach the week of May 22nd.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS: Sunset Beach operates on a 9-guard rotation with an adult supervisor and a head guard as additional support. Guards are expected to protect the life and well-being of all facility patrons, prevent people from getting themselves and others into dangerous situations, supervise and control the activities and area of Sunset Beach Swimming facility, supervise patrons from either a walking or a lifeguard chair position, provide proper lifesaving and first aid measures per Red Cross procedures, check the lake/beach area and support facilities daily to ensure for safety and cleanliness, properly care for and utilize all rescue equipment

ADDITIONAL JOB FUNCTIONS: Other assigned tasks as necessary to ensure the efficient operation of the facility. As part of employment with Sunset Beach, guards are afforded the opportunity to also work for Kimberly School District as a swimming lesson instructor for additional hours before the beach opens for general swimming M-Th in June and July

QUALIFICATIONS: Either current certification or the eligibility to take and successfully pass certification courses in American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer certification or equivalent, American Red Cross First Aid Certification or equivalent, and American Red Cross Lifeguard Training certification or equivalent. Certification must be obtained no later than June 2nd, 2023.
