



Parks & Street Operator – Entry Kimberly, Wisconsin

The Village of Kimberly (pop. 7,320) is located in the Heart of the Fox River Valley in Northeast Wisconsin. Kimberly boasts a small-town atmosphere within a large metropolitan area. As part of the Fox Cities, Kimberly offers excellent employment opportunities for area residents and services that are exemplary.

The Village of Kimberly is seeking a Parks & Street Operator to join our team. The Parks team is responsible for maintaining approximately 110 acres of park land throughout the village including: 3 soccer fields, 5 baseball/softball fields, 6.7 miles of paved walking trails maintained for year-round use, 10 playgrounds, 6 pickleball courts, 6 rentable shelter spaces, a parks urban forest canopy, a boat and kayak launch, and a sand beach swimming facility. The parks team also supports the street department in seasonal maintenance of 35 miles of concrete urban roadway with curb and gutter. As a full-service municipality, the Village provides automated refuse collection services, special item collection, and seasonal leaf pick up with leaf vacuum operations. We are seeking candidates that thrive on workplace variety as many operations are seasonal in nature or are structured on a scheduled basis.

The position works under the general direction of the Parks Lead and is expected to carry out duties independently and in a team setting.

Experience is not required for this entry level position. Class B Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement is required or the ability to acquire within one year of hire.
