



## Street Foreman Kimberly, Wisconsin

The Village of Kimberly (pop. 7,320) is located in the Heart of the Fox River Valley in Northeast Wisconsin. Kimberly boasts a small-town atmosphere within a large metropolitan area. As part of the Fox Cities, Kimberly offers excellent employment opportunities for area residents and services that are exemplary.

The Village of Kimberly is seeking a Street Foreman to join our team. This position is responsible for supervisory duties in managing, planning, and directing the activities of all Street/Park Operators. The activities include maintenance of 35 miles of concrete urban roadway with curb and gutter, sanitary/storm sewer maintenance, snow/ice control, refuse collection, street line painting, and upkeep of our urban forest canopy. As a full-service municipality, the Village provides automated refuse collection services, special item collection, and seasonal leaf pick up with leaf vacuum operations. The foreman duties involve the exercise of safety mindedness, mature judgement, and planning ability. We are seeking candidates that thrive on workplace variety as many operations are seasonal in nature or are structured on a scheduled basis.

The position works under the general direction of Public Works Director/Zoning Administrator and is expected to carry out duties independently and in a team setting.

This is a skilled position requiring at least 3 years of public works experience. Class B Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement is required. Current salary range: approximately \$56,825 - \$77,000 annually. Excellent benefit package.
