# A Note from the Director

### 2024 - Time spent outdoors is time well spent

The Village of Kimberly Parks and Recreation Department is proud to present well maintained public spaces in Kimberly for the enjoyment of all. New and exciting amenities that are open or will be opening in 2024 include a little something for everyone. Check out the new concrete corn hole boards in Sunset Park near Shelter #1. Either bring your own bags or check out a set from the library and challenge your friends to an impromptu tournament. Explore the newly completed Papermill Run Trail featuring breathtaking views of the Fox River and the Kimberly hydro dam as well as providing safe access to the Washington Street bridge if you plan to explore trails outside of Kimberly such as Island Park Trail in Little Chute as part of the completed Loop the Locks trail network. Later this summer, the new Sunset Beach Splashpad will be ready for your splashy enjoyment! This new amenity will feature a fuchsia octopus and will allow the village to extend "water season" outside of the traditional beach season. Coming in August Verhagen Park will be receiving a new playground to replace the existing structure. This new playground will feature a "kid powered" electronic game console inspiring active play. The Village is actively engaged in a fundraising initiative to fund poured in place surfacing to truly allow this playground to be accessible for people of all abilities. Work will begin in 2024 on a new trail system connecting Kimberly Avenue with Railroad Street along Kennedy Avenue and Marcella Street with activity on that project slated to begin late 2024 and the trail officially opening in 2025. Work will begin on the new Street and Parks Department building at our 426 W. Kimberly Avenue location - please visit our amazing staff at the Municipal Complex (our temporary office space) for all shelter rentals or other parks and rec related questions.

In addition to the "new and shiny" things coming to Kimberly this year, we are proud to present some of our tried and true traditional programming as well. Youth baseball season will be in full swing this May - July, we have several opportunities for your child to become a certified babysitter, and our Park's hosted events will again welcome thousands of people to Kimberly Parks. Enjoy a walk on our robust connected trail system, take in the sights and sounds of nature around you, and find yourself in Kimberly Parks.

We look forward to seeing you in the parks this year at one of our many seasonal community events, a rec program, a dip at the beach, a boat ride on the Fox River, or a quiet walk in the park. The Village of Kimberly truly is a great place to live, learn, work and play.

bean bag toss boards, concessions, family changing rooms, tables and chairs, sand beach, sand toys for castle building, lounge chairs, rentable shelter space, and an outdoor shower to rinse off the sand before heading home. # A few things to remember while visiting Sunset Beach:

♦Sunset Beach is a smoke free facility, please refrain from smoking, including e-cigarettes, within the facility!

♦ Carry-ins are permitted, but no glass containers or alcoholic beverages are allowed for your safety.

♦ Coast Guard approved type I/II/III life jackets including puddle jumpers are permitted on swimmers. The only other swim aid allowed are pool noodles, no water wings or other inflatables. We do have life jackets available in the guard house!

Please note, we have updated hours for the 2024 swimming season! Join us for open swim: Monday - Saturday 12 p.m.- 6 p.m. and Sunday 12 p.m. - 5 p.m. Please note we will have a water break scheduled at 3 p.m. each day where the water will be cleared for 20 minutes. Patrons are welcome to remain in the facility but will need to stay on the sand or grass as all lifeguard staff are on a break at this time.



# Boat and Accessible Kayak Launch

Boat and kayak launch are located at 300 Sunset Park Drive, use the west entrance to Sunset Park. Annual permits for Sunset Park Boat Launch are available for purchase right at the boat launch. Bring your credit card and pay for a day pass or annual pass right at the launch! Daily launch fees are \$5, annual pass fee is \$15 resident rate and \$25 non-resident rate plus tax.
